Payment terms:

- Invoices are issued on the 15th of each month for all sessions booked for the following month. Payment is due on the 1st of the month (*for example, we'll invoice you on 15th August for September's sessions, which will be due for payment on 1st September*)
- For ad-hoc sessions booked after we issue your monthly invoice, payment is due within 7 calendar days of invoicing

Ways to pay:

Bank Transfer, Government Tax-Free Vouchers and all Workplace Vouchers.

Late and Non-payment Fee:

- 10% of the total bill after 10 working days
- An additional 10% of the total bill after 20 working days, and possible suspension of the child's place
- After 8 weeks of non-payment, court proceedings will be initiated. All legal and court costs will be included in the final bill, including any tracing fees.
